English for High School Preparation

The English for High School Preparation course at TAFE NSW is for students aged 15 or over who want to improve their English skills before starting a high school study abroad program. The course:

- Introduces you to Australian teaching and learning practices
- Teaches you about Australian culture
- Prepares you to communicate with schoolmates in an Australian high school.

Course length: 5 - 25 weeks; 25 hours of classes per week

Level: elementary to intermediate

Ages: 15 to 18 years old

There are 6 TAFE NSW English Centres in Sydney and New South Wales. They are situated on the TAFE campuses and are government owned and operated. The highly-qualified teaching staff have extensive experience providing English language preparation for high school students.

Classes combine English language, study skills and English for key high school subjects. Sample subjects* include:

- Introduction to Australia
- English for Maths
- English for Science
- English Literature
- Pronunciation
- Introduction to Australian Schools
- Language Laboratory

* Timetable will vary from location to location*

Students in the High School English Study Abroad program study with other high school-aged students.

Your success in this course is very important. All TAFE NSW English Centres have a dedicated coordinator who provides pastoral care and guidance for international students. The coordinator maintains contact with Homestay host families to ensure each student adjusts to life in Australia and successfully advances with their studies. Students have regular tests and assignments, and progress reports are sent to parents and guardian.

Arrival Services and Accommodation

All TAFE NSW English Centres provide orientation services and can arrange airport reception for students. Many also arrange excursions and day trips for students.

Airport reception and transfer to your Homestay host family can be arranged.

A highlight of the High School English Study Abroad experience is the opportunity to live with an Australian family. Homestay provides a unique opportunity to learn more about Australian life and improve English language skills by living and sharing with an Australian host family.

Students have a safe place to live with their own bedroom, a study desk and a shared bathroom, and are provided with two meals a day and 3 meals on the weekends. It is a requirement of the NSW Department of Education and Training for all High School Study Abroad students to live with an approved host family during their stay.

All host families are accredited and undergo a police check before students arrive. Homestay families are welcoming and the host parent takes on the role of guardian/carer for students. Students often develop friendships with their host families which last for many years.

Homestay:

In Sydney A\$250 to A\$300 per week

In Newcastle, Wollongong and Port Macquarie: A\$220 to A\$250 per week

All students must purchase approved Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for the period of their studies.
Overseas Student Health Cover: \$194 (6 months)
